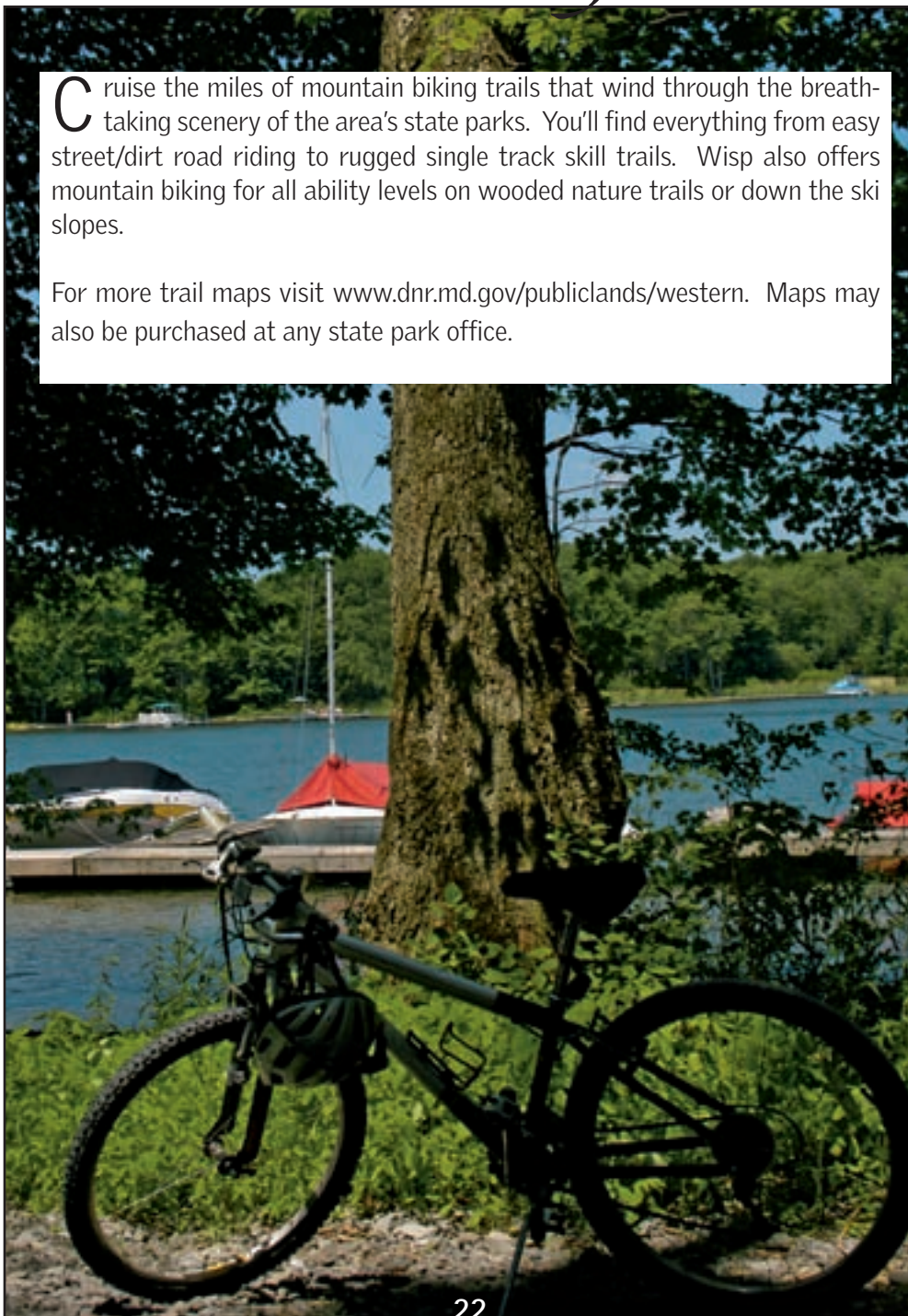


mtn biking
